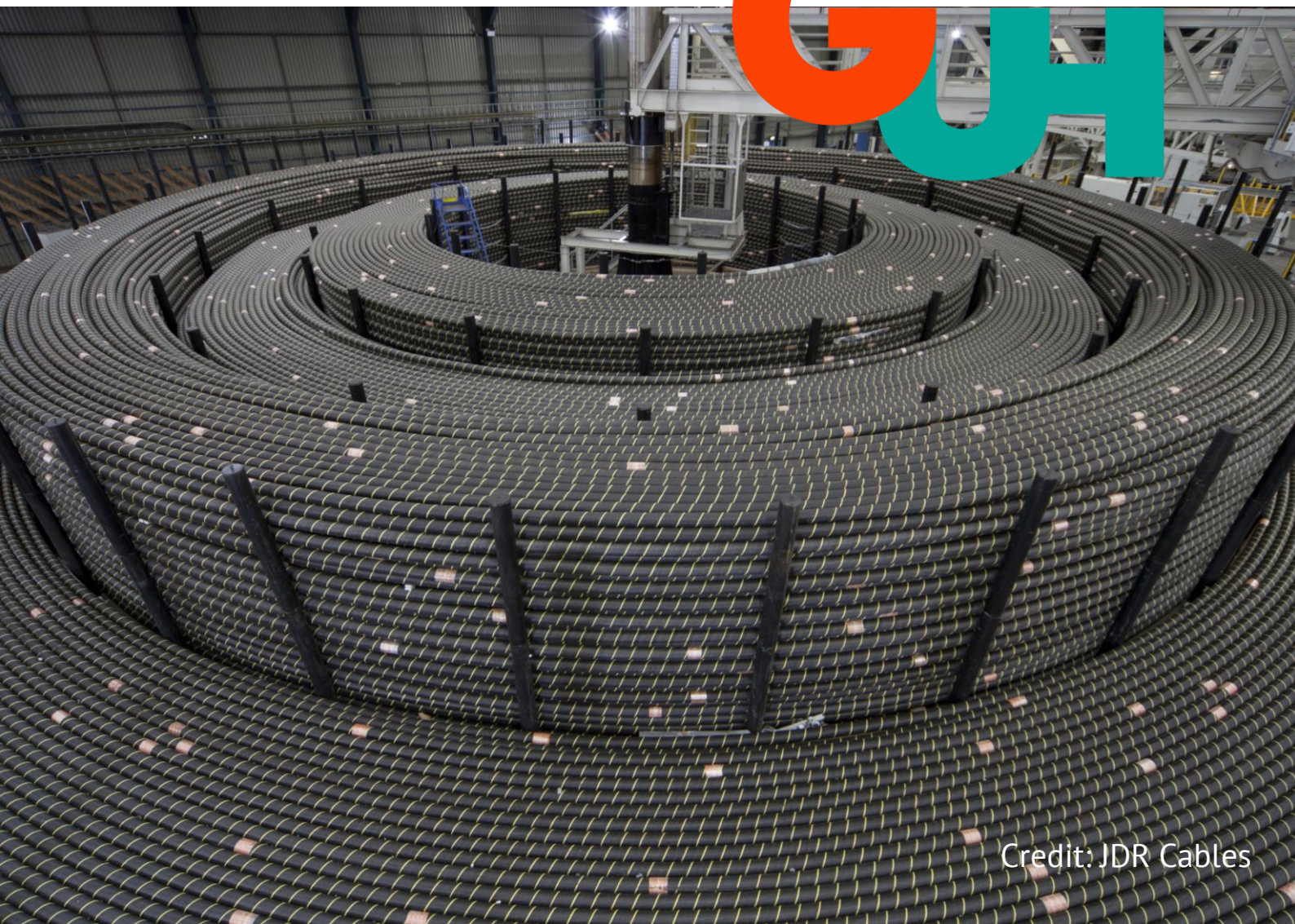

Christina works in the Supply Chain team at Great British Energy, supporting the growth of the Energy Engineered in the UK (EEUK) programme, with a current focus on offshore wind and electricity networks.

Her work spans GBE's funding mechanisms, supporting investment in UK-based manufacturing and strengthening the domestic supply chains needed to deliver the energy transition. She also works on GBE's Deepwater Commercialisation Programme, where she leads a workstream focused on unlocking the industrialisation and serialisation of floating offshore wind.

Before joining GBE, Christina worked at McKinsey, supporting major organisations to improve performance and build new analytical and technology capabilities. Prior to this, she spent several years in New York leading teams and working with major global brands on digital transformation. Having also lived in Orkney, where the opportunities presented by abundant renewable energy are hard to miss, her career has helped shape both her approach to the energy transition and her enthusiasm for windy days.

Across her career, Christina has focused on turning ambitious strategies into practical delivery, with her current work centred on building the industrial capability needed to support the UK's clean energy transition.

Deepwater Wind Symposium

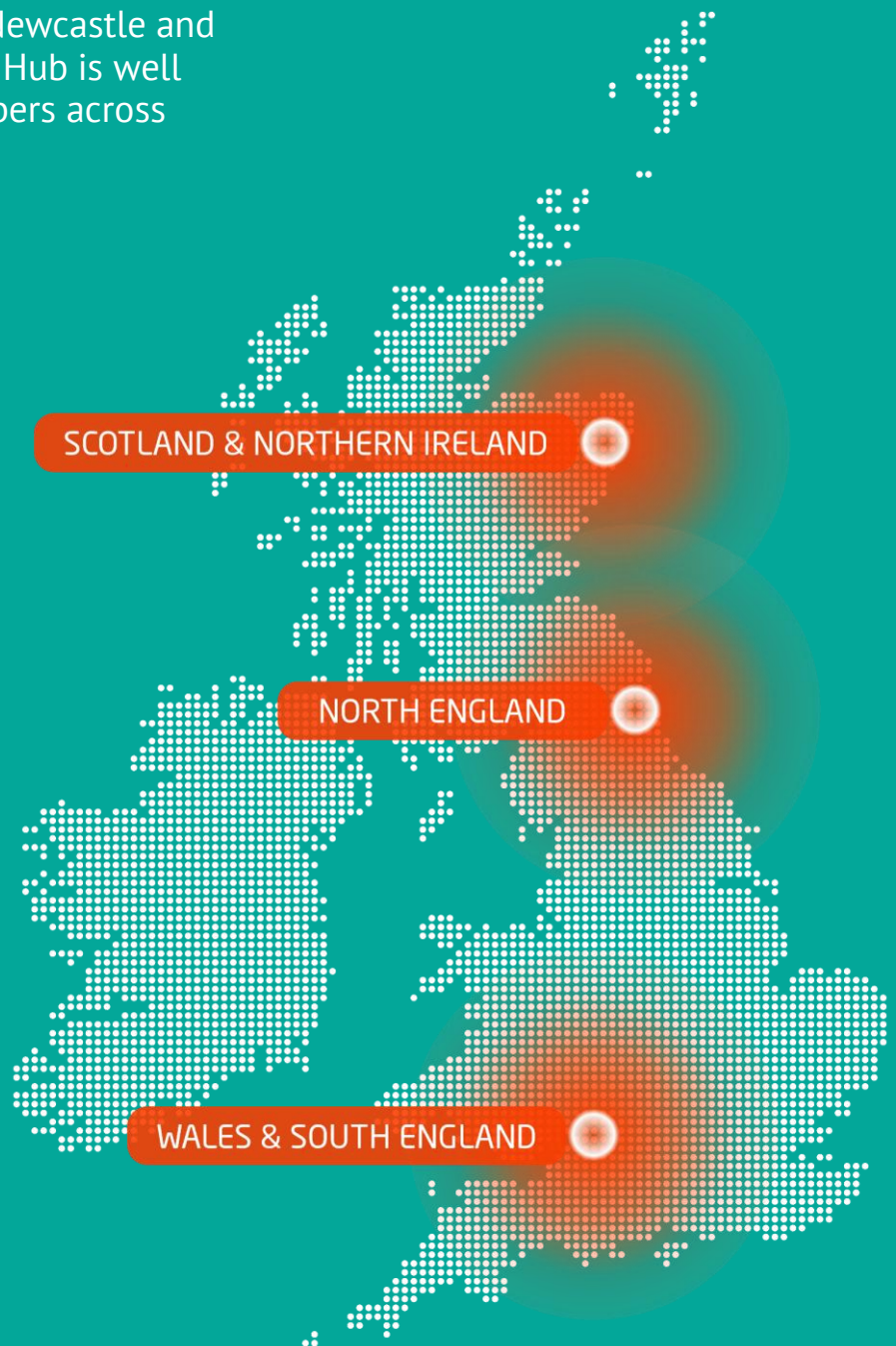
