Global Underwater Hub is hosting a **Offshore Mooring and Anchoring Systems Conference and Workshop** in Newcastle on **Wednesday, 06 March 2024**.

The event is part of a series of focused events which will deep-dive into the critical areas of **opportunity** and **challenge** within the underwater engineering space with a view on the changing market dynamic that a shift to offshore wind will bring. Following on from successful events in 2023 and a continued programme of work within the subsea cable space, GUH is bringing together key industry stakeholders to discuss **underwater mooring** and **anchoring systems**.
